## **Rules and Regulations: All The Art Hall Rules Plus: Check in 3-6 P.M. Monday June 19th**

All exhibitors must be grown in Henry County or adjoining counties. The exhibitor must be the owner/ raiser of the product. All fruits and vegetables must be on disposable plates failure to do this will result may result into a disqualification. Dispose of all buckets of soil by removing from fair grounds. No dumping soil in trash cans! Judging of vegetables and fruits will be judged on quality, uniformity, edibility, arrangement and attractiveness. Immature items are allowed in class. Attractiveness of display is considered when judging class 1413.

### **Class 1: (2016 Crop)**

- 1400 - One quart jar of small grains – any kind
- 1402 - One quart jar of soybeans
- 1403 - One quart jar of shelled corn
- 1404 - Best 4" slice of Alfalfa
- 1405 - Best 4" slice of grass hay
- 1406 - Best 4" slice of mixed hay
- 1407 - Best 4" slice of Oat/Wheat straw
- 1409 – Longest Ear of Corn
- 1410 – Best Popcorn (5 ears)
- 1411 – Best Indian or Calico Corn (3 ears)
- 1412 – Any other not Listed
- 1413 - Best display of farm grains and products from above classes (5 kinds)
- 1414 - Corn 2017 Crop Single Hill (or) Stock grown outside in bucket. State planting date on 3x5 note card.
- 1415- Soybean single plant 2017 Crop grown outside in bucket. State planting date on a 3x5 note card.

- 1426 - Pea Pods (3)
- 1427 - Zucchini (1)
- 1428 - White Onions (3)
- 1429 - Yellow Onions (3)
- 1430 - Leaf lettuce
- 1431 - Radishes with 2" tops (3)
- 1432 - Spinach (with root in container of water) (1)
- 1433 – Berries – any type (½ cup)
- 1434 - Rhubarb with tops (3 stalks)
- 1435 - Bean (3)
- 1436 - Any other kind not listed
