**Rule 1:** All **Food** items must be on a disposable plate and be in a zip lock plastic bag. **Sewing** must be on a hanger, ready to hang. It may be covered with plastic. **Single Fresh Flowers.** Must be in bud vase or plastic container. **Single Fresh Flowers and Vegetables and Fruits** may be GROWN BY THE EXHIBITOR OR EXHIBITOR'S FAMILY. They are to be attractively displayed using your choice of accessories, baskets, toy truck, etc. Rhubarb should be on a disposable plate or in an aluminum pie tin. Berries should be in non-breakable plastic containers. All artwork **MUST be ready to hang** with a sturdy cord or wire or entry will be disqualified. All photographs must be framed or mounted. Any size photo. No computer altered photos. **COLLECTIONS AND SOUVENIRS** can be OWNED BY EXHIBITOR OR EXHIBITOR'S FAMILY. All collections have a table area of 18"x24". Collections can be mounted on cardboard.
