RULES AND REGULATIONS

Rule 1 Heifers must be recorded solely in the junior's name.

Rule 2 No exhibitor will be allowed more than two entries per class. May enter only one Pair of Heifers in a class.

Rule 3 Exhibitor must furnish official Health Certificate required by state. Health papers must be checked. All Heifers not accompanied to the show by registration papers, must show AOB classes.

Rule 4 4-H members showing in the Junior Show must pay entry and stall fees.

Rule 5 Exhibitors must furnish their own tie-out material. All livestock tie-outs, trucks, trailers, etc., must park in the designated livestock area or you will forfeit your premiums. All Cattle tie outs in North Lot.

Rule 6 Heifers and steers must be checked in and weighed by 10:00 a.m. Friday, June 22, 2018.

Rule 7 Breed classes are Angus, Shorthorn (1/2 Blood and Higher), Simmental (1/2 Blood and Higher), Hereford, and Crossbred AOB. Registration papers and health papers must be turned in to the superintendents on all purebred females.

Rule 8 Steer classes are Angus, Shorthorn (1/2 Blood and Higher), Hereford, Simmental (1/2 Blood and Higher) and Crossbreds.

Rule 9 Release time – Saturday after the show. Due to the high cost of postage, all premium checks are to be picked up in the Secretary's Office before the exhibitor leaves the fairgrounds. The superintendent will let no one leave until all checks are picked up. If the check is not picked up, the exhibitor will forfeit their premium check to the Fair Association. If you would like your **check mailed** to you, please bring a **self - addressed, stamped envelope to the Secretary's Office** (or purchase in the fair office) by 8 p.m. Sunday, the last day of fair.

Rule 10 All Classes are subject to change at Superintendent's Discretion.

Rule 11 Heifers may be shown as either breeding or market beef but not both.

Rule 12

1. Any boy or girl, who during the year has conducted a supervised 4-H or FFA program, with records kept therein, may enter the Junior Livestock Division. A minimum age of 8 as SEPTEMBER 1, 2017 is required to participate in the State Fair Junior Livestock Division.
2. Programs may be done under the supervision of:
 - A. 4-H leaders or Extension staff members
 - B. Teachers of Vocational Agriculture
3. Illinois 4-H members exhibiting in the Junior Livestock Division of the Illinois State Fair must be active 4-H club members, as verified by the County Extension Office and at least 8 but not yet 18 years of age on September 1, 2017. Active Illinois FFA members, as verified by local Teachers of Vocational Agriculture, may participate.
4. Individuals previously enrolled in Illinois 4-H or FFA programs and under 21 years of age as of September 1, 2017, may participate in the Junior Livestock Division of the Illinois State Fair provided they are active FFA members as verified by Illinois FFA and in accordance with one of the following options:
 - A. Maintain active membership on the roster of their local high school FFA Chapter;
 - B. Maintain active membership in a collegiate FFA Chapter in a post-secondary institution of higher education in the State of Illinois; or
 - C. Maintain active membership in an Illinois FFA Alumni Chapter. FFA members must not have reached their 21st birthday as of September 2017.

Rule 13 If Breed numbers fall below five animals then breed will be combined with others.

Rule 14 Ownership of Steers should be February 1st and Heifers May 1st of the current year.

Rule 15 We will follow the fitting and ethics rules set by the Illinois State Fair Junior Show.

Rule 16 Animal must be the property of the exhibitor, unless exhibitor has more than one animal in the same class. If showing animal in Junior the exhibitor must also show that animal in Open Classes.

Rule 17 For Safety Reasons: **No Butt Fans will be allowed, All fans must be hung from above. A limit of 1 fan per 3 animals.**

Rule 18 No equipment in walkways (wheelbarrows, lawn chair, fans, etc.)

Rule 19 No trimming chutes will be allowed in cattle barns after the last show day.

Rule 20 No beef cattle will be allowed in any other livestock area or barns. This includes grooming, feeding or watering.

Rule 21 If you want to be staled next to someone, please specify on entry form.

Rule 22 No bucket calves.

Rule 23 Cow/Calf pair cannot be shown together in other Group classes.

Rule 24 Calves shown in Cow/ Calf classes must be born in current year.

Rule 25 All Market heifers must be open (not bred) at the time of the show.

Rule 24 Class breaks may change at the discretion of the superintendent.



*****It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to clean the stalls before premium checks are issued or before leaving the fairgrounds.*****

Rule 1 A committee of representative breeders will screen steers entering the Purebred Steer Classes. A blood type test will be performed on a purebred steer, if deemed necessary by the committee, at the exhibitor's expense.

Rule 2 Classes for crossbred steers & market heifers will be established after all entries are weighed.

Rule 3 Additional classes will be added in any breed at superintendent's discretion.

Rule 4 All steers to be on grounds by 9am and checked in by 10am Thursday, June 21, 2018.
