Identification Individual identification of each animal shall be by a USDA official animal identification number ear tag, ("840" tag). The identification tag must be able to be read both visually and electronically.

RULES & REGULATIONS:

1. **Weigh-in for all swine will be Monday, June 15, 2026 from 8 am to Noon and then from 1 pm to 3 pm. Weigh-in workers and Pork Ambassadors will weigh first. No pigs may arrive on the fairgrounds before 6 a.m. Monday, June 15, 2026. Swine may leave the fairgrounds after the Open Show or Jr. Show. All other hogs must be off the fairgrounds by 10 a.m. Friday, June 19, 2026.**
2. When coming to the fair, all swine should enter the northeast gate of the fairgrounds. Health certificates must accompany all swine.
3. Barrows and gilts will not exhibit against each other in any classes.
4. Classes will be divided by weight according to number of entries.
5. Barrows, market gilts and breeding gilts must weigh between 150 - 300 lbs. (hogs will be weighed only once).
6. Health papers must be turned in to the Fair Office upon arrival.
7. Any pigs not meeting stated weights WILL NOT have the opportunity to show in ANY class (except showmanship). Additional pigs may be brought as substitute entries for those disqualified by weight and must meet the same health requirements.
8. All livestock tie-outs and trucks, trailers, etc., must park in the North lot or you forfeit your premiums.
9. 4-H and Junior Swine are eligible for the Open Swine Show if proper entry fees are paid.
10. Barrows and gilts shown only in Thursday's Junior Open Show will be released immediately after the show.
11. Due to the high cost of postage, all premium checks are to be picked up in the Secretary's Office before the exhibitor leaves the fairgrounds. If the check is not picked up, the exhibitor will forfeit their premium check to the Fair Association. A social security number is required for the release of the check. If you would like your check mailed to you, please bring a self-addressed, stamped envelope to the Secretary's Office by 5 p.m. Sunday, the last day of fair.
12. Purebred gilts will be shown by age.

Individual identification of each animal shall be by a USDA official animal identification number ear tag, ("840" tag). The identification tag must be able to be read both visually and electronically.

Rules and Regulations:

1. Weigh-in for all swine will be Monday, June 15, 2026 from 8 a.m. to Noon and then for 1 p.m. to 3 pm. Weigh-in workers and Pork Ambassadors will weigh first. No pigs may arrive on the fairgrounds before 6 a.m. Monday, June 15, 2026. Swine may leave the fairgrounds after the Open Show or Jr. Show. All other hogs must be off the fairgrounds by 10 a.m., Friday, June 19, 2026.
2. When coming to the fair, all swine should enter the Northeast gate of the fairgrounds. Health certificates must accompany all swine.
3. Health papers must be turned in to the Fair Office upon arrival.
4. Any boy or girl who is at least 8 years of age, but not yet 21 years of age, on or before September 1, 2025 is eligible to show in the junior classes.
5. Only junior exhibitors will be allowed to show. Any and all conflicts must be cleared through the Swine Superintendent. All animals must be owned by the exhibitor.
6. Barrows, market gilts and breeding gilts must weigh between 150 - 300 lbs. (hogs will be weighed only once).
7. Livestock tie-outs, trucks, trailers, etc., must park in the North Lot or exhibitor will forfeit premiums.
8. Due to the high cost of postage, all premium checks are to be picked up in the Secretary's Office before the exhibitor leaves the fairgrounds. A social security number is required for the release of checks. If the check is not picked up, the exhibitor will forfeit their premium check to the Fair Association. If you would like your check mailed to you, please bring a self-addressed stamped envelope to the Secretary's Office (or purchase in the office) by 8 p.m. the last day of fair.
9. Ownership of animals must be at least 60 days!
10. Purebred gilts will be shown by age.
